- 4. Proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation process set out in the request for proposals document. The following weightings shall apply to Rated Criteria (including technical and non-price factors): 60% and for Bid cost: 40%.

All envelopes marked "FINANCIAL PART" shall remain unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Purchaser until the second public opening.
- 8. All Proposals must be accompanied by a Proposal Security of USD 90,000.00 (USD Ninety Thousand) or ETB 12,600,000.00 (ETB Twelve Million Six Hundred Thousand) or equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency.
